The Village of Winnetka is pleased to announce that as part of the Village's commitment to improving and managing stormwater conveyance the Village will begin the construction of the "Boal Parkway Pump Station Project" beginning Tuesday, August 11th.

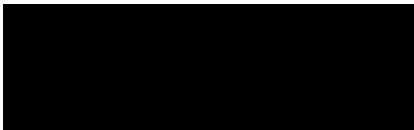
This project will include the installation of a new storm water pump station near the private entrance to 1550 and 1548 Tower Road, the installation of a new storm inlet structure, and the replacement of the storm sewer flap gates for the outfall pipes into the East Diversion Ditch. The proposed improvements have been designed to improve the management of the storm water within the Boal Parkway area. Prior to the commencement of construction, the Village will be removing designated trees near the proposed pump station location and new inlet structure. The tree removal activities are expected to take place on Friday, August 7th.

The proposed work activities will not interfere with any of the residents on Boal Parkway and will not affect the current storm water drainage in the rear of your property. The Contractor anticipates that most of the larger excavation work will be completed within 3 weeks from the start of construction. As work progresses, additional notification letters will be provided to you, offering information on the project scheduling and any major milestones.
